The New Zealand Organic Wine Awards is not affiliated with Organic Wine New Zealand, or Wine New Zealand. We are however members of OWNZ and strongly support the work that they undertake. Furthermore we resolutely agree with OWNZ's stance on certification for organic vineyards. All wine submitted to the New Zealand Organic Wine Awards must be produced from 100% certified organic or in-conversion grapes.

We thank our sponsors Riedel New Zealand, and Over The Moon Dairy. Without your kind assistance we would not be able to operate these awards.

Thank you for your patience throughout COVID-19, and the disruption that it has caused to the NZ Organic Wine Awards. # **Observations**

Once again this year saw the New Zealand Organic Wine Awards receive an increase on previous entries. We now have over 40 vineyards as part of the New Zealand Organic Wine Awards. Wine submissions were up around 10% on last year. This growth comes from new vineyards eligible to enter the awards, wineries deciding to enter the awards for the first time, and our existing member vineyards having more wines eligible for entry.

Pinot Noir was one again the largest varietal class. Sauvignon was our second most entered varietal followed by Pinot Gris and Chardonnay.

45% of wines entered originate from Marlborough, a sizeable increase from 2019. 20% of entries were from Central Otago wineries, with a similar number from North Canterbury. Other regions include Hawke's Bay, Gisborne, Northland and Nelson.

For 2020 we issued 46 Gold, 49 Silver and 52 Bronze. Organic Wine growing allows for greater expression of terrior, vintage as well as characteristics not typically associated with a varietal, we believe this impacts the judging of top performing wines, particularly when judging complexity elements, which increase the score, pushing more wines into to the 'gold bracket'.

We uphold a strict threshold for gold, silver and bronze medal wines, to ensure that consumers can be assured of a top quality wine from a gold medal winning wine, as well as from silver and bronze. Many great wines are not awarded a medal, however we want to assure our consumers the very best of what New Zealand's organic wines have to offer.

# **Pinot Noir**

As with the previous two seasons, Pinot Noir has been our most substantial varietal category. 10 Pinot Noirs were awarded gold medals, of these wines 4 were grown in Central Otago, 3 in Marlborough, 2 in North Canterbury and one in Nelson. Our 2020 Champion Pinot Noir is Amisfield's Breakneck Reserve Pinot Noir 2017.

# Sauvignon Blanc

6 Sauvignon Blanc's were awarded gold in 2020. Sauvignon Blan entry numbers were up 20% from 2019, with the largest gain in entries from Marlborough. Our judges noted the continued prevelance of barell fermented Sauvignon Blanc amongst entries. Our champion Sauvignon Blanc is Walnut Block's Collectables Sauvignon Blanc 2019.

# Riesling

Afte ra number of years with strong Riesling entries, 2020 saw a marked drop in numbers, we do not yet know the reason for this. 5 gold medals were awarded to Riesling, of these 2 originate from Otago, 3 from North Canterbury. Riesling had the highest % of Gold Medals per entry than any other varietal. Our Champion Riesling for the second year running is Amisfield's Lowburn Terrace Riesling 2018.

# **Pinot Gris**

Following the trend from the past two seasons, we have seen an increase in the number of Pinot Gris' entered, which is our third largest varietal category. The highest volume of Pinot Gris entries were from Marlborough Wineries. The 2018 champion Pinot Gris and wine of the show is "Peregrine Pinot Gris 2019".

# Chardonnay

After a lower Chardonnay turnout in 2019, Chardonnay entries hit a new high in 2020. The majority of entries came from Gisborne and Marlborough wineries, although North Canterbury also showed well. Our 2020 Champion Chardonnay is Seresin's Estate Chardonnay 2018.

# Rose

We saw a host of first time Rose entries in 2020, as the varietals popularity grows in NZ. Once again the majority of entries are Pinot Noir Rose's.

Our champion Rose is The Glover Family Vineyard's Zephyr MK1 Rose.

# **Syrah**

Two regions submitted Syrah entries for 2020, Hawke's Bay and North Canterbury, with wineries in both regions attaining a gold medal. 2020's Champion Syrah is Terrace Edge's 2015 Syrah.

# Sparkling

We saw an increase in the number of sparkling entries this year, including the inclusion of a couple of Pét-nat's. We have this year awarded the Champion Sparkling to Quartz Reef for their Methode Traditionnelle Late Disgorged Vintage 2010, which was released to celebrate 21 years at Bendigo. Sadly only 500 bottles have been released. Without doubt the finest example of a NZ sparkling.

For the first time the RIEDEL winery of the year accolade heads south to Central Otago. Accruing an impressive 7 gold medals in 2020 from 9 entries is an impressive feat by any standards. The consistently high standard of wine being produced at Amisfield is astounding. Winemaker Greg Lane and assistant Ben Leen, as well as previous winemaker Stephanie Lambert should be lauded for their successful efforts in transitioning Amisfield towards organic certification and exceptional standard of winemaking.
