The Aotearoa NZ Organic Wine Awards is an independent wine show committed to discovering and promoting New Zealand's best organic wines.

2021 is our eighth year of operation. Once again the number of entries has grown, signifying the huge momentum NZ Organic wines have.

The New Zealand Organic Wine Awards is not affiliated with Organic Wine New Zealand, or Wine New Zealand. We are however members of OWNZ and strongly support the work that they undertake. Furthermore we resolutely agree with OWNZ's stance on certification for organic vineyards. All wine submitted to the New Zealand Organic Wine Awards must be produced from 100% certified organic or in-conversion grapes.

We thank our sponsors Riedel New Zealand, and Over The Moon Dairy. Without your kind assistance we would not be able to operate these awards.

Following a difficult year, and an especially testing harvest, in 2020- I hope the results of the 2020 vintage wines provide some compensation that all the extra harvest-time effort of social distanced picking, reduced headcount and contact tracing, was well and truly worthwhile.

I'm heartened to see the continued growth of the organic wine sector in New Zealand. The momentum is well and truly with us, and long may it continue.

Observations

For the eighth consecutive year we have experienced growth in entry volumes at the Organic Wine Awards. As with the trend in 2020 we have witnessed a rise in the number of participating wineries from the Central Otago Region. This could be due to the high prevalence of Central Otago certified organic vineyards, although could also in part be due to the high levels of success Central Otago wines enjoy at the awards.

Winery entrants were up 5%, and total wines entered up 10%. A number of wineries that have previously entered wine have chosen to expand their entry to encompass more wines. This could be to capitalise on a good vintage, build on existing success, or as more vineyard is converted to organic.

A few previous entrants chose not to enter, in the main, timing was the issue. The entry is around harvest time and small wineries are very busy, as well as a time many wineries have lower stocks of wine. We will consult with entrants to ascertain if the timing is still working for everybody.

North Canterbury dominated the champion wines this year, taking 5 of the possible 8 champion trophies.

For 2021 we issued 8 Champion, 41 Gold (excluding champions), 53 Silver and 56 Bronze. Organic Wine growing allows for greater expression of terrior, vintage as well as characteristics not typically associated with a varietal, we believe this impacts the judging of top performing wines, particularly when judging complexity elements, which increase the score, pushing more wines into to the 'gold bracket'. It is also worth noting that the entry standard for the Aotearoa Organic Wine Awards tends to be higher than many other awards, owing to the fact that many 'Premium NZ Wineries' are also organic.

This logic correlates with over-representation of organic wineries in lists such as Real

Review Top Wineries and the NZ Fine Wines selection.

We uphold a strict threshold for gold, silver and bronze medal wines, to ensure that consumers can be assured of a top quality wine from a gold medal winning wine, as well as from silver and bronze. Many great wines are not awarded a medal, however we want to assure our consumers the very best of what New Zealand's organic wines have to offer.

Pinot Noir

Pinot Noir saw the largest uptake in entries this year, despite already being the largest varietal class for the past 3 awards seasons. The reason for this is most likely the prevalence of Central Otago wineries at the awards. 11 Gold medals were awarded to Pinot Noir's, of which 6 are from Central Otago, 3 from Marlborough and 2 from North Canterbury. Vintages ranged from 2016 through to 2020, with both of these vintages being represented in the gold medal awards. The Champion Pinot Noir is Rippon's "Rippon" Mature Vine Pinot Noir 2017.

Sauvignon Blanc

6 Sauvignon Blanc's were awarded gold in 2021. SB entry volumes were consistent with 2020. Of the 6 gold medals, 3 are from Marlborough wineries, 2 from Central Otago and 1 from Nelson. The champion Sauvignon Blanc is Amisfield's Sauvignon Blanc 2020.

Riesling

Riesling entries were up for 2021, although still not at levels seen pre-2020. 5 Riesling's were awarded Gold medals this year. The Champion Riesling was Terrace Edge's Liquid Geography 2020.

Pinot Gris

Pinot Gris is the fourth most popular varietal, slipping just below entry volumes for Chardonnay, despite an increase in entries this year. 4 Pinot Gris' were awarded gold, 2 from Central Otago, 1 from Nelson and 1 from North Canterbury. This year's Champion Pinot Gris is Terrace Edge's 2020 Pinot Gris.

Chardonnay

For 2021 Chardonnay has overtaken Pinot Gris as the third largest varietal class. This is largely due to the addition of some new wineries to the awards who specliase in the varietal. 6 Chardonnay's were awarded gold. The Champion was Greystone's Chardonnay 2019.

Rose

The prevelance of Rose continues to grow at the Aotearoa Organic Wine Awards. Rose entries were up nearly 20%. The majority gold medal rose's originate from Central Otago, however the champion is North Canterbury's Terrace Edge Rose 2020.

Syrah

Syrah entry volumes were flat with 2020. Gold medals were issued to 3 Syrah's, with one each going to North Canterbury, Hawke's Bay and Marlborough. The 2021 Champion Syrah is Greystone's 2018 Syrah.

Sparkling

Once again Sparkling entries have been split between Methode Traditionelle and Pet Nat. Despite no Pet Nat's being awarded gold, it was acknowledged that the standard was very high amongst all sparkling entries. The champion Sparkling is Quartz Reef's Methode Traditionnelle Vintage 2015 Blanc de Blancs.

Receiving 3 varietal champions, and a further 3 Gold Medals, the Family owned and operated North Canterbury vineyard is a well deserving recipient.
